### RACESAFE JUNIORS

Great Britain's all-female Racesafe Junior squad came away from Fontainebleau silver ladies after winning team and individual silver medals. The team comprising Elicia Miller with her own A Sunny Bay, Sasha Hargreaves and her own Playtime, Georgia Bartlett with her own Spano de Nazca and Heidi Coy with her own Royal Fury

completed on a combined score of 91.3, sandwiched between gold medal winners France on 86 and Germany on 92.9. Heidi and Royal Fury's double clear inside the time also elevated them from sixth after dressage to eventual silver behind France's Anouk Canteloup with Daniel del Impermeable. Germany's Brandon Schafer-Gehrau took bronze with Fraeulein Friedo 10. Great Britain's individual rider, Leila Paske, finished 39th with Fernhill First Friend after picking up 20 cross country jumping penalties.

Team GBR was the only team to complete on its dressage score, prompting Junior Coach Caroline Moore to comment: "They were all exceptional and did personal bests. I was very proud as they kept their cool and executed the plan that we had put in place. We knew what the tracks would be like and the types of lines they'd be faced
